






## GHG Reporting Overview

On this page, the first chart indicates an overview of the 3 scopes, and the second chart indicates the Scope 1 GHG Emissions











Meridian sends monthly reports to Stakeholders to facilitate a dialogue for improvements, efficiencies, and sustainability.

# Railcar Safety & Compliance

Meridian Chemicals, LLC is fully committed to compliance with RR Tank Car Regulations including Non-Destructive Testing (NDT) and the requalification of tank cars, ensuring the highest standards of safety, reliability, and operational excellence.

The company adheres to all applicable guidelines set forth by the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) and the Association of American Railroads (AAR), including periodic inspections, testing, and certifications required to maintain tank car integrity. Non-destructive testing methods, such as ultrasonic and magnetic particle testing, are employed to thoroughly assess tank car structures for signs of fatigue, corrosion, or defects, ensuring continued safety and performance.


Meridian Chemicals also ensures that all tank cars in its fleet are requalified within the prescribed intervals, addressing the specific service conditions and materials transported. 





### 2023 Waste Disposal Metrics

Meridian must occasionally send railcars to a certified waste disposal facility to remove due to the accumulation of "Heel" which prevents the railcar from being loaded/unloaded efficiently. The heel consists of the lignin and cellulose fibers from pulp mills which buildup in the railcar over time.

The charts to the right show the approximate waste disposed of by year. Meridian strives to report our waste as accurately as possible and bases all assumptions on data analysis from invoices and waste manifests.
